The General Assembly adopted a resolution granting to Palestine the status of non-member observer State in the United Nations. The vote was 138 for, 9 against, with 41 abstentions. CHAPTER VII RECOMMENDATIONS (III). 1. In the course of the informal meetings of the Committee to explore solutions, a working group was set up to deal with the federal-State proposal. 2. The Working Group in the Federal State Solution (Sir Abdur Rahman, Mr. Emezam, Mr. Simic, and Mr. Atyeo) formulated a comprehensive proposal along these lines and it was voted upon and supported by three members (India, Iran, and Yugoslavia) at the forty-seventh meeting of the Committee on 27 August 1947. Both Israel and the previous U.S. administration opposed the General Assembly's resolution asking the ICJ to render its opinion on this question. Not surprisingly, Israel and Israel's supporters in the U.S. have sought to dismiss the standing of the International Court's opinion because it is "non-binding" and "merely advisory."
