The Yale St. Thomas More Project has now completed the formidable task of editing this work, and offers it complete, with parallel English (1557) and Latin (1565) texts, a full textual apparatus that lists all the major variant readings from Hardyng's and Halle's Chronicles, a collation of all extant manuscript versions, and, for the first time in full, the important early. [The Introduction](#) discusses the development of the text and the circumstances under which it was composed, and there is a commentary which translates major passages preserved only in the Latin versions and examines the relationships between the texts. Richard Sylvester is assistant professor of English at Yale University and executive editor of the St. Thomas More Project. (Volume 1 in preparation.) Volume 15 concludes Manton's exposition of Hebrews 11, with sermons on the faith of the Israelites crossing of the Red Sea, the conquest of Jericho, and the life of Rahab. This volume also includes two treatises: [A Treatise on the Life of Faith](#) and [A Treatise on Self-Denial](#) along with 18 sermons preached on special occasions, including a sermon preached before Parliament and three sermons on the sacraments.
