Library acquisitions is the department of a library responsible for the selection and purchase of materials or resources. So, check the book's circulation status. To search for an e-book, use the library's main digital catalog. Use scholarly databases to find journals and peer-reviewed articles. If you need news or magazine articles, go to the online newspaper or magazine edition. The evaluation of the sources is another crucial part of research paper writing. To do it properly, answer three simple questions: who, when, why? WHO? Who created the work? What are their credentials? Who published the book/article? Who are the readers?
