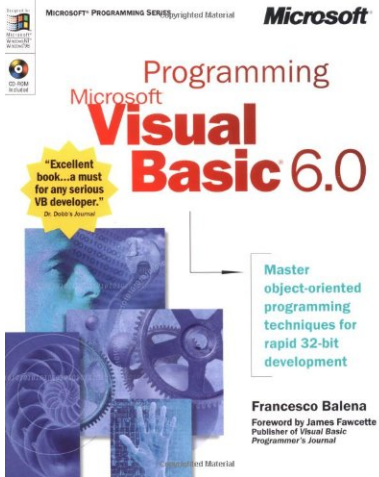

Powerbasic gives you features crucial to working with the WIN32 , as well as with other languages. One simple example is its support for multiple procedure/function calling conventions. The last version of Visual Basic I actually did any programming with was VB 5.0 Professional. For this article series (and some other projects) I searched for (and found) a New "Old Stock" copy of Visual Studio 6.0 (in a sealed original package) and purchased it. It was a rare find.
