Do buy this book ifâ€¦ You want to have something that covers the cornerstones of making conversation. You have Aspergers (Or are on the autism spectrum), or simply want to make sure to build your knowledge from the ground up. Do NOT buy this book ifâ€¦ You want something that focuses only on conversations. You have social anxiety: The book doesnâ€™t talk about how to deal with anxiety and nervousity in conversations.
