A practising landscape designer, Professor Achva Benzinberg Stein appreciates that to understand a nation's gardens one must understand its topography and climate, its flora and fauna, its history and its culture.

While some gardens have no planting at all, decorative zellij tilework and intricate plaster carving enlivens even the most austere courtyard. Stein traces three basic design motifs: geometric forms that reflect the Muslim interest in numerology, arabesques adapted from traditional Persian designs, and calligraphy inspired by the Koran.
