A progress report should be project-centered, which means it should refer to the work done by your team and not to the plans or expectations of your supervisors. A progress report should be simple and concise. Avoid writing lengthy, dense documents. In most cases, a progress report is submitted on 2-3 pages. A progress report not only provides decision-makers with necessary information, but it also shows them what kind of specialist you are. Do and Don't. Do. Do be specific when writing a progress report. Making vague statements or being emotional in the progress report is not what supervisors want.
