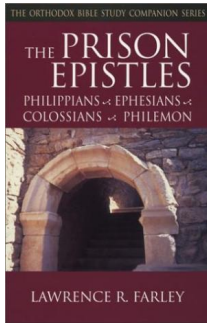

They include Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon. Together they comprise four of the New Testament's 27 books and 15 of its 260 chapters. The first three of these epistles were written to specific local groups of Christians in the cities for which the books were named.
