All of them had gone out in the forest to collect tendu leaves and fodder for cattle. One Sita Chouke (63) from Kokewada village... In the second incident, a woman was killed in area under Ordnance Factory Chanda, falling under Chaprala beat of Bhadravati range. The woman, whose identity could not be ascertained, too had gone to collect tendu leaves and was killed instantly by the tiger. In another incident, one Rama Aadku Marbate (70), a resident of Nirphranda village, was killed by a tiger when she had gone to the forest to collect fodder for cattle.
