For those who labored in the mills and made the short walk home to the company boardinghouses, "the Boott" was both workplace and living quarters. Skilled and unskilled alike toiled 12 hours a day, six days a week, seldom straying beyond the confines of the town. Before the mill corporations moved in, the site where Lowell would be built was an isolated farming community.
