A Venice reprint from 1734-1760 is basically the same, except that it combined May vol. 7 and the propylaeum, and it didn't include September vols.6-8, October 7-13, or any of November or December. A Brussels supplement to this (ed. Greuse) provided Sept. 5 and 8, and October 1-6. A Paris reprint of 1863-1870 (edited by Palm) assigned a number to each volume. There are three further volumes, listed at Brepols here as 69, 70, and 71; and then the Acta Sanctorum Tables Generales (1900), listed as 72. Online volumes " Original Antwerp Edition. Since I compiled the list above, volumes of the original printing have started to come online.
