His father was a mason which had a great deal of impact on Hardy's later decision to become an architect. He began schooling at the age of six and after when Hardy was old enough to find a permanent profession, he was inclined to follow in his father's foot steps. At 21, Hardy began his work in Dorchester. He worked for John Hicks, who was a friend of his father's.
